About St Louise

Housing for homeless women in London

St Louise is a general needs hostel, providing temporary housing for women aged 21 years and over. St Louise offers 95 bed spaces in the London borough of Westminster. Applicants can be referred by a relevant homeless agency or self refer and they do not need to have a connection within the borough. The maximum stay for all residents is two years.

The hostel is laid out over six floors, comprising single room accommodation with shared kitchen and bathroom facilities. There are two self contained flats, one of which is shared by two residents. Kitchens and bathrooms are shared by up to eight people. Fridges,

cookers, microwaves and kettles are provided in the kitchen with individual cupboard space for resident's kitchen utensils and food.

There is a communal lounge, with access to computers and free Wi-Fi. There is also a communal garden and laundry room.

St Louise is staffed 24 hours a day. Day staff work between 8am and 8pm, with security staff on duty between 8pm and 8am and at weekends.
